The Process

Attendance Requirements for Liberty Tech Charter School

For the 2017-2018 academic year, Liberty Tech Charter School is open to all student in kindergarten through ninth grade who reside inside the state of Georgia, subject to seat availability. Students of a parent who is a member of the governing board or a full-time employee of Liberty Tech Charter School are given first preference during the lottery, or students who are siblings of current Liberty Tech Charter School students are given first preference during the lottery. All other students submitting a completed application during the Open Enrollment period have an equal chance of being selected through a random selection process.

Monday through Friday from 12:00 until 3:00 pm (Open Enrollment closes on February 3 at 2:30 pm)

The deadline for receipt of the Student Application and Parent Agreement is 2:30 pm on Friday, February 3, 2017. All applications must be submitted in person during the Open

Enrollment period to 119 Price Road, Brooks, GA 30205.




